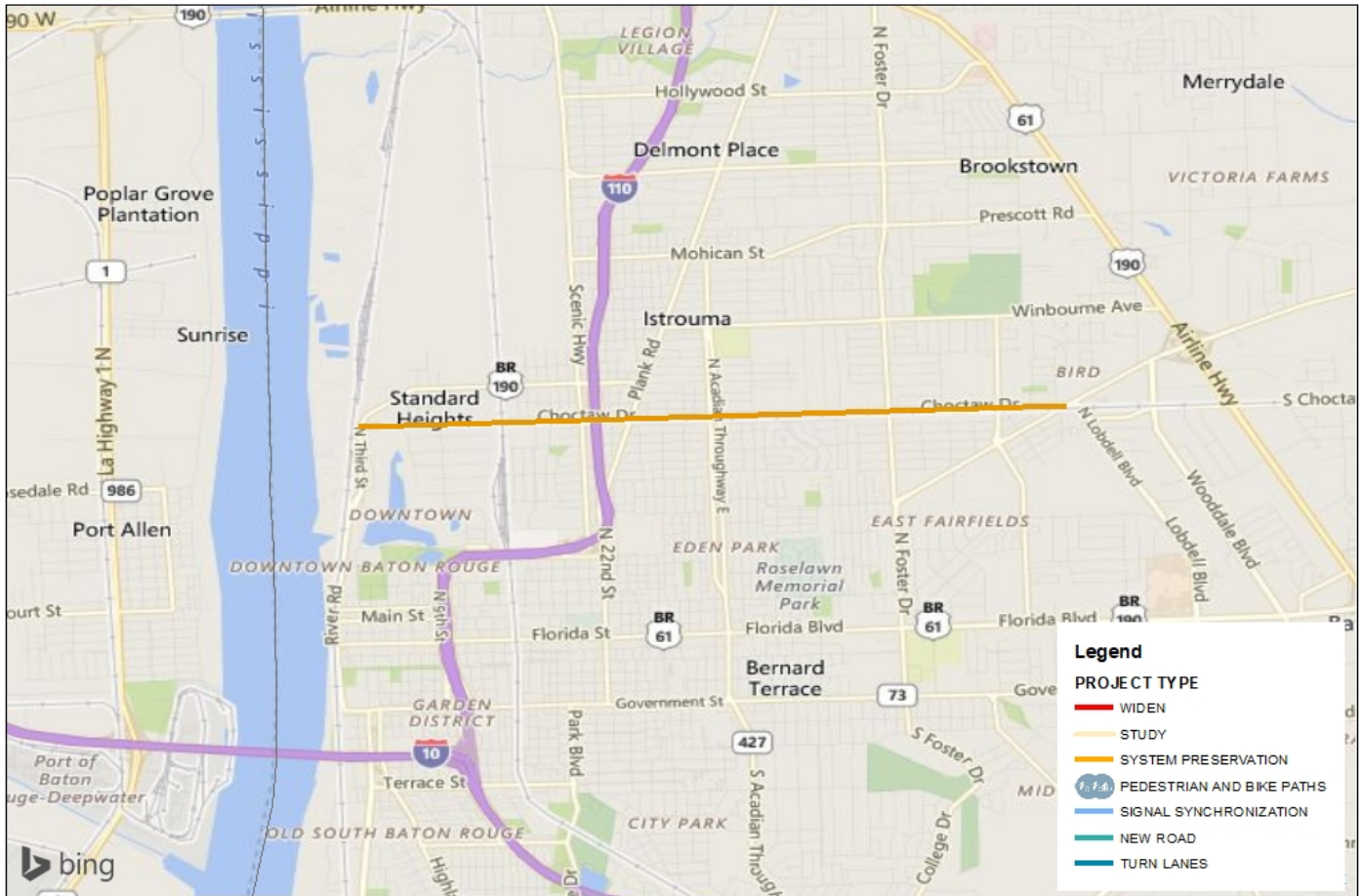

## **Project Background**

This project was approved as part of the 2014 Call for Projects. It is a reconstruction and rehabilitation project on Choctaw Road in Baton Rouge, from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to Greenwell Street. Choctaw Road is minor arterial roadway, which runs west to east.

## **Amendment Details**

The original \$3.85M figure was an assumed planning estimate, based on 2" of asphalt. The revised engineering cost estimate increased to 3" of asphalt, resulting in the cost increase.

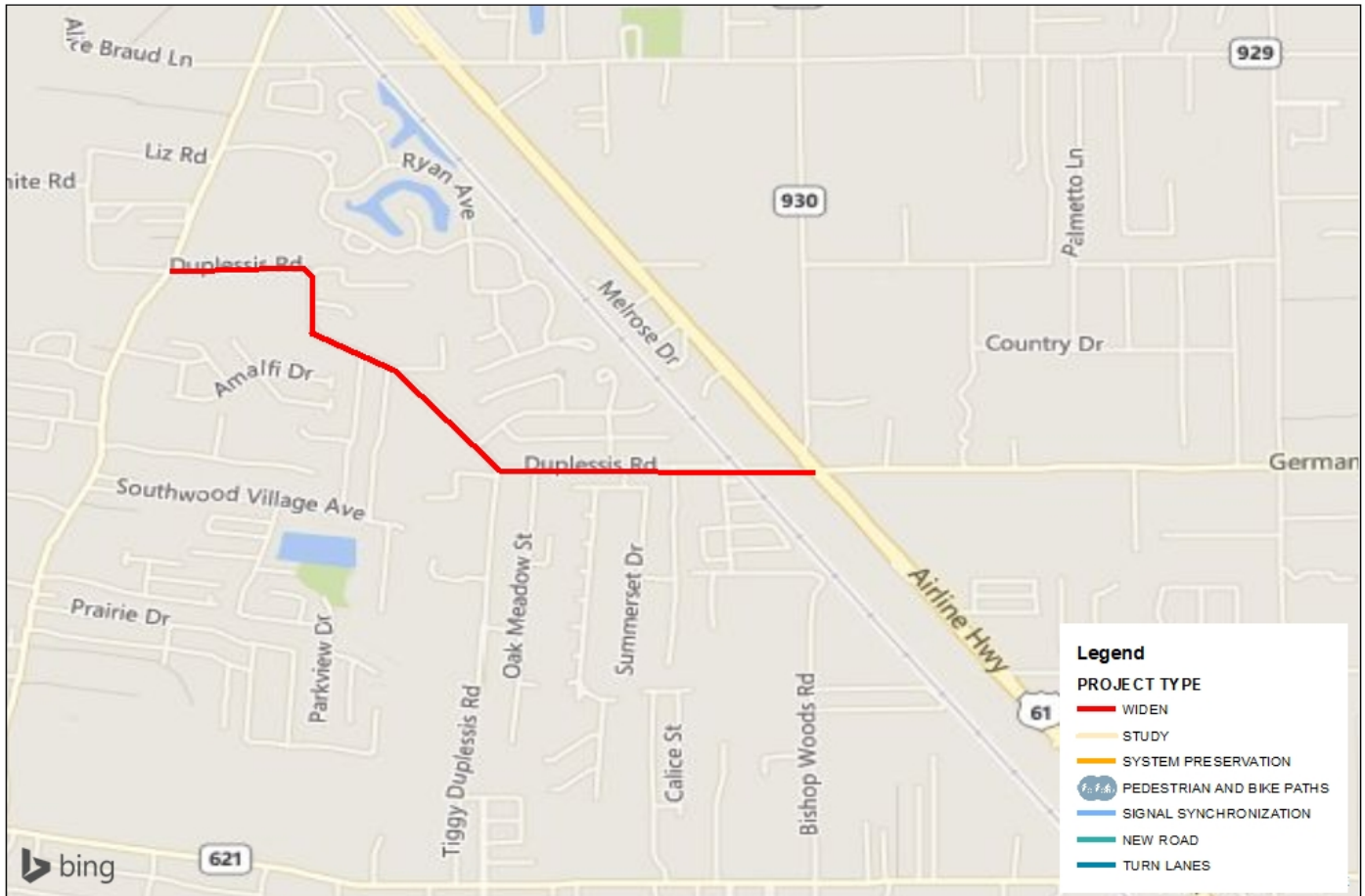

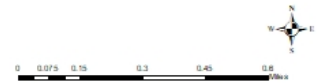

## **Project Background**

This project was submitted in the 2017 Call for Projects. It is a roadway safety improvement project on Duplessis Road in Ascension Parish, from US 61 – LA 73. Stage 0 for this project has been approved by DOTD, and a project number assigned. Duplessis Road is classified as a *major collector* roadway.
