

H.013116 LA 20 Widen: LA 307 -S. Vacherie-Lafourche and St. James Parishes/SCRSC-RWD This project will widen LA 20 to 2-12' lanes and 8' shoulders on both side of the travel lanes, along with centerline raised pavement markers, centerline and edge line rumble strips. Additionally, the existing bridge will be replaced. H.013770 LRSP Signing and Striping (Iberia) – Iberia Parish/Acadiana Reg-RWD This Local Road Safety Program project

August

H.015111 US 61: Int. Improvements at Alco Ave-East Baton Rouge Parish/Capital-INT This project will install two Jturns with 2 raised medians, ultimately restricting left turning movements at the intersection of US 61 and Alco Avenue.

H.013751 Downtown Greenway LA Connector (BR)-East Baton Rouge Parish/Capital Reg -Non-M This Safe Routes to Public Places Program will install sidewalks and/or shared lane pavement markings along Eddie Robinson Sr. Drive and Louisiana Avenue.
