NARRATIVE

Please describe additional capacity-building activities conducted during the quarter.

Quarter 1 of the RCBG program for Region 7 has been a base-building, planning, and support-building phase. These activities can be separated into three separate categories:

(1) Coordination meetings with OCD and OCD contractors: Activities include coordinating around invoicing, program and project updates, trainings, check in calls, and consultant coordination calls. Specific examples of these activities are as follows: An interview with Spears Group for the development of a regional outreach and engagement strategy; Listening in on the rain gauge network update; Work on the RSC workplan; Compliance training.

(2) On-boarding and knowledge sharing with stakeholders and potential RSC members: Activities include meeting with parishes, potential RSC members, and other regions to share knowledge, discuss the program, and determining next steps as regional buy-in and state alignment around activities became more developed. Specific examples of these activities are as follows: Meetings with Parish staff and officials; Attending Amite River Basin meetings; Attending Home Builders Association meetings; and a Knowledge sharing meeting with Plan Acadiana.

(3) Coordination meetings with LSU, who is contracted to do work to support Region 7: Activities include meeting with LSU professor, Dr. Thomas Douthat, and students doing related work. Specific examples of these activities are as follows: Discussing LSU scope of work and deliverables; Updating LSU on application status; and discussing LSU progress on deliverables.

Successes during this quarter include: (1) Receiving the notice to proceed for the RCBG program. (2) The November 18, 2019 meeting, while prior to the beginning of quarter 1, set the tone for people across Region 7 to understand expectations of the phase 2 application, to get to know other potential nominees, and to set expectations for potential activities that will be completed by the RSC. (3) Contracting with LSU to complete work that supports the work of Region 7.

Challenges during this quarter include: (1) The beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic in the United States.

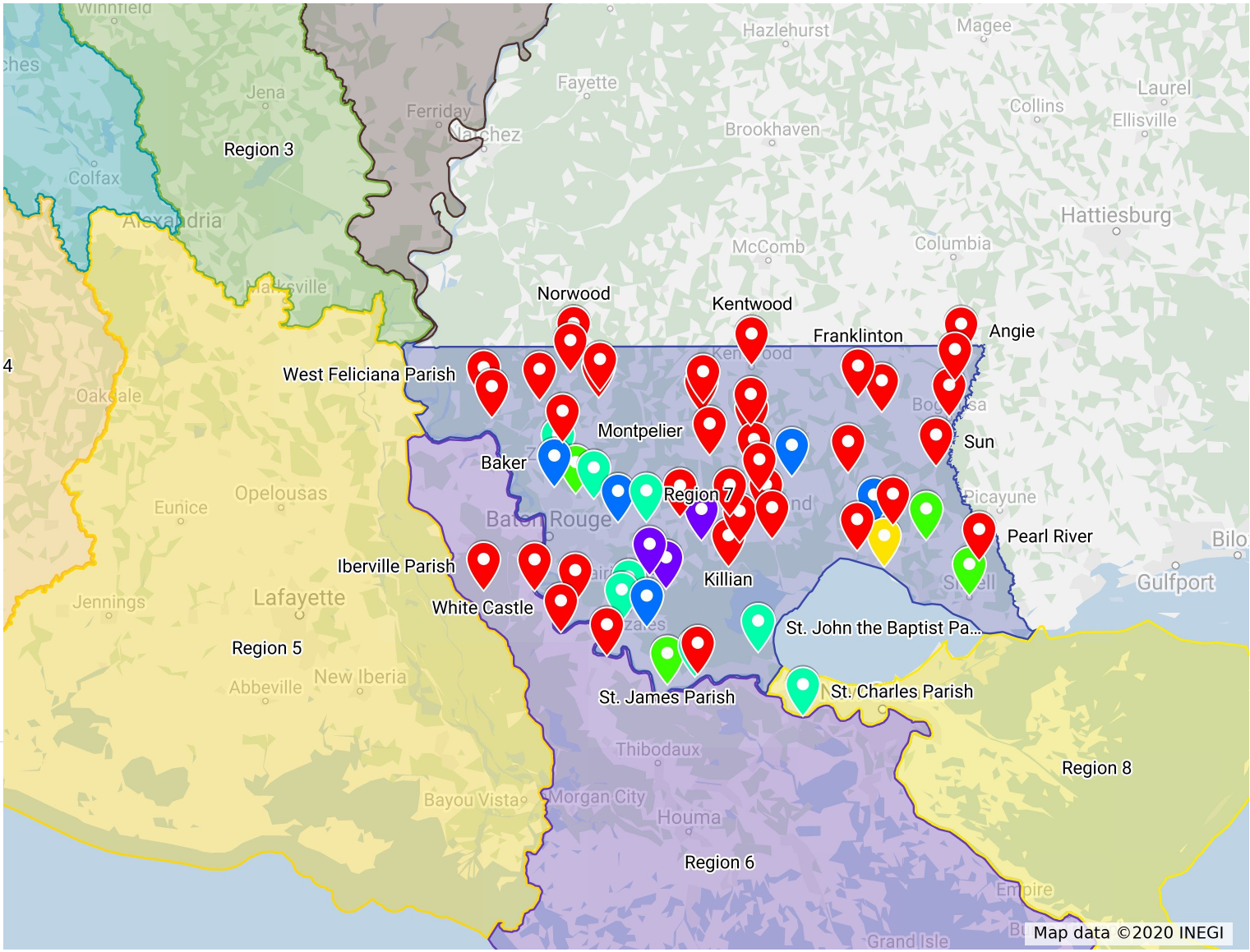

The six key elements of a Regional Concept for Transportation Operations are:

- Motivation ("Why"): Reasons for developing an RCTO based on regional needs, goals, or operational concerns.
- Operations Objective ("What"): Desired near term outcome(s) in terms of transportation system performance and related performance measures.
- Approach ("How"): Overall description of how the operations objective will be achieved.
- Relationships and Procedures: Institutional arrangements, memoranda of understanding (MOUs), protocols, information sharing, etc.
- Physical Improvements: Facilities, equipment, systems, etc.
- Resource Arrangements: Sources and use of funding, staff, equipment, etc.

Regional Cooperation Topics

Regional Models of Cooperation can be applied to a diverse array of transportation planning examples of topics that agencies have focused cooperative efforts around include:



Air Quality and Environmental Planning: By their very nature, environmental quality issues do not stop at jurisdictional boundaries. Comprehensive solutions to environmental issues often require cross-jurisdictional planning and joint efforts.



Asset Management: Assessing infrastructure conditions is a key aspect of a transportation system. Infrastructure owned and operated by different agencies overlap and connect throughout States and metropolitan areas. Agencies are working together to collect infrastructure condition data and to develop tools to track and analyze maintenance programs.



Congestion Management: Commuting patterns, particularly those in densely populated or rapidly expanding metropolitan areas, often cross metropolitan areas or State boundaries. Managing congestion at a regional scale often requires comprehensive regional planning efforts, such as data sharing agreements and committees.



Economic Development: An efficient transportation system is often the lifeblood of a vibrant regional economy. Successful economic development initiatives require working together agencies from a variety of sectors, including transportation, private industry, local government, and other regional organizations. Working across jurisdictional boundaries allows agencies to better navigate economic trends and act on opportunities that fuel the economies of regional conglomeration.



Environmental Justice Analysis: Environmental justice populations often include those such as commuting from central cities to suburban job centers, which require crossing jurisdictional boundaries. Without careful planning, they may face disproportionate impacts from regional transportation investments. Transportation agencies are working together to assess the impacts of transportation decisions on environmental justice communities and create regional transportation plans that better serve these and other vulnerable populations.



Freight Planning: Freight is by nature a regional and megaregional planning phenomenon. Freight routes cross planning boundaries in order to move goods from one region to another and throughout the country. Because of the strong private sector involvement in freight transportation, cooperation with non-traditional stakeholders and innovative approaches to soliciting input from the private sector is a common tactic in freight planning.
