This Safe Routes to School Program project will construct sidewalks along N 5th Street and LA 1151, and a shared use path along N 4th Street.

This Safe Routes to Public Places Program project will construct sidewalks along Gillman Street and Jenkins Avenue in the vicinity of I.A. Lewis Elementary School.


